



HEALTHY WORKPLACE ECOSYSTEM FUTSAL CHAMPIONS LEAGUE 2019 RULES & REGULATION

1. OVERVIEW

- 1.1 The Healthy Workplace Ecosystem Futsal Champions (HFC) League consist of four types of competition:
 - (i) Group playoffs
 - (ii) Wildcard playoffs (if qualified)
 - (iii) Semi-final playoffs
 - (iv) Finals
- 1.2 Teams will compete against one another from mid July 2019 onwards in group playoffs. Qualified teams will either advance to wildcard playoffs and/or semi-finals in August 2019 before moving on to finals, which will be held on 28 September 2019.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The HFC League is open exclusively to all Companies based within a Healthy Workplace Ecosystem (HWE). The list of HWEs are indicated in Annex A.
- 2.2 Each Team must have seven (7) players five (5) players and two (2) substitutes. Teams with less than 7 players registered and/or showing up for the League will be disqualified.
- 2.3 The Team Captain is required to complete and submit the Registration Form and all players are required to complete and submit the Indemnity Form and Code of Conduct to be considered for the League. Incomplete submission will lead to a disqualification to participate in the League.
- 2.4 The Team Captain will be required to confirm or re-submit the names of players to the League Official thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition. All players are required to register their attendance at the registration booth at their stipulated reporting time before they are eligible to compete on that day.
- 2.5 Each player can only register and play in **ONE** Team.

3. LEAGUE FORMAT

3.1 The League shall be conducted and governed in accordance with the Futsal Soccer-5 Rules and Regulations. Team Captains and Players are required to ensure that all matches are played in the spirit of the game as provided by the rules and regulation of the League.





- 3.2 The duration of play for each match shall last fifteen (15) minutes, comprising of two equal periods of seven (7) minutes, with one (1) minute of break in between.
- 3.3 After the kick-off match has kicked off, each Team is allowed an unlimited amount of "rolling" substitutions.
- 3.4 The Match Official's decision on the field is FINAL. No appeal against the Match Official's decision shall be allowed and entertained.
- 3.5 Teams will play in round robin format during the group, wildcard and semifinal playoffs. Knock out format will be used at the finals.

4. POINT SYSTEM & SYSTEM TO BREAK TIE

- 4.1 For round robin format, three (3) points will be awarded for a win, one (1) point for a draw, and zero (0) point for a loss.
- 4.2 The ranking of teams shall be determined in the following criteria:
 - Greater number of points obtained in all group matches.
 - Greater goal difference in all the group matches.
 - Greater number of goals scored in all the group matches.
 - If two or more teams are equal on the basis of the above criterion, their place shall be determined as follows:
 - o Greater number of points obtained in the group matches between the teams concerned.
 - Goal difference resulting from the group matches between the teams concerned.
 - Greater number of goals scored in the group matches between the teams concerned.
 - Fewer number of points according to the number of yellow and red cards received in the group matches (Yellow Card = 1 point. Red Card as a consequence of two yellow cards = 3 points. Direct Red Card = 3 points. Yellow Card followed by a direct Red Card = 4 points).
 - Drawing of lots
- 4.3 The finals will be conducted in single leg 'knockout' basis. The teams will be playing in several knock out rounds to determine the top 3 teams.
- 4.4 In the event the scores are tied after end of regulation time, the winner shall be determined by penalty kicks. Sudden death penalty kicks will commence when both teams are still tied after each team has taken 3 penalty kicks.





5. PRIZES

5.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 Teams under the Champions League.

6. DISCLAIMER
